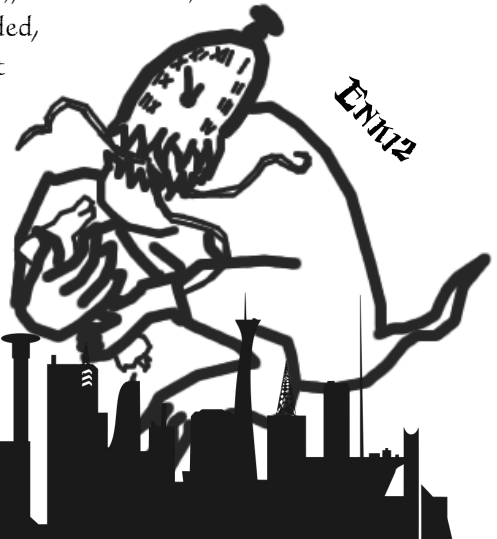


ETHONIC CHRONOS
